Memorandum of Understanding

Agreement on mutual information exchange and collaboration between I-SAAE and ASCCT.

We, the President of **the Society for Alternatives to Animal Experiments - India (SAAE-I)** and the President of the **American Society for Cellular and Computational Toxicology (ASCCT)** have agreed to sign this memorandum to strengthen the friendship, capabilities and interaction between our two societies.
